10. Any Contractor registered with Central Government/ any State Government/ any PSU may participate in the tender but registration with the Public Health Engineering Department, Bihar in requisite class will be essential after issue of LoA.
11. The bidder shall submit his bid/tender on e-Procurement platform at www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in.
12. The bidder must have the class I/II Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) with signing+ Encryption and user-id of the e-Procurement website before participating in the e-tendering process. The bidder may use their DSC if they already have. They can also take DSC from any of authorized agencies. For user-id they have to get registered themselves on e-procurement website www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in and submit their bids online on the same. The offline bids shall not be entertained by the tender inviting authority for the tenders published in e-procurement platform.
13. The bidders shall submit their eligibility and qualification details, technical bid, financial bid etc, in the online standard formats given in e-procurement website at the respective stage only. The bidders shall upload the scanned copies of all the relevant certificates, documents etc, in support of their eligibility criteria/technical bids and other certificates/ documents in the e-procurement website. The bidder shall

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digitally sign on the supporting statements, documents, certificates uploaded by him, owing responsibility for their correctness/authenticity. The bidder shall attach all the required documents for the specific tender after uploading the same during the bid submission as per the tender notice and bid document.

14. All the required documents should be attached at the proper place as mentioned in the e-forms otherwise the tender of the bidder will be rejected.
15. Tender Processing Fee (TPF) to be paid through e-payment mode (i.e. NEFT/RTGS, Credit/Debit Card and Net Banking) only.
16. The cost of the BOQ/form fee to be paid through e-payment mode (i.e. NEFT/RTGS, Credit/Debit Card and Net Banking) only.
17. Earnest Money Deposit" (EMD) can be paid either through e-payment or manual mode (only BG).
Note: "Bids along with necessary online payments must be submitted through e-procurement portal www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in before the date and time specified in the NIT. The department/tendering authority will not take any responsibility for the delay/non submission of tender/ non reconciliation of online payment caused due to non-availability of internet connection, internet traffic/holiday or any other reason."
18. The tender opening will be done online on www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in only.
19. Any corrigendum or date extension notice will be given on the e-procurement website only.
20. Bidder must qualify following Eligibility Criteria:
 - (i) Achieved in any one year during the last five years, a minimum annual financial turnover (in all classes of civil engineering construction works) volume of construction work of at least the amount equal to 5% (five percent) of the estimated cost of the works for which bid has been invited. The turnover will be indexed at the rate of 8% for a year.

OR

New bidders registered / having applied for registration with Govt. Department and having financial capability but no prior turn over but willing to bid, shall be eligible to participate in the tender provided an additional Bank Guarantee to the tune of 2% of estimated cost of the works for which bid has been invited and having validity till the period of work completion duly pledged is submitted with the technical bid of the tender.

The additional Bank Guarantee as required above is in addition to mandatory deposits as per bid documents/ conditions for participating in the tender.

- (ii) "Satisfactorily completed civil engineering construction work of value not less than 5 % (Five percent) of estimated value of work in any one year during last five financial years."

OR

New bidders registered / having applied for registration with Govt. Department and having financial capability but no prior work experience but willing to bid, shall be eligible to participate in the tender provided the conditions regarding additional Bank Guarantee as mention in Clause- 20 (i) above is fulfilled.

21. Bank Guarantee issued from any Schedule Bank within state (If issued from any bank outside state then it will be converted to any bank within state before executing the work agreement) and valid up to 225 days after the date of receipt of tender.
22. Detailed terms and conditions of tender will be enclosed along with the Bidding Document, and will be binding on the tenderer.

The bidders must submit an affidavit separately with the bid document that they are not liable for disqualification as per clause 4.8 (Instruction to bidders: Section 1 General) of the Bid Document.

4. The bidders have to quote their price in financial bid in two sections namely Section A: Execution part and Section B: Operation and Maintenance part.

The bidders shall not quote less than 35% of the quoted price of Execution part (Section A) for the operation and maintenance part (Section B), otherwise their bids will be treated as invalid.

25. The bidders are advised to visit work sites before submission of tender to study local conditions, availability of labour and material etc.

26. Deposit of additional performance guarantee for serious unbalanced rate: -

The tenderer quoting serious unbalanced rate will have to furnish the rate analysis of the work along with the reason as how the work will be finished in the stipulated time frame and they will have to deposit additional performance guarantee money at the time of agreement as per prevailing rule for example:-

- (a) If 0 to 5% less than BOQ rate additional performance guarantee will be @ 0.25% for every 1% less rate.
- (b) If 5 to 15% less than BOQ rate additional performance guarantee will be @ 0.5% for every 1% less rate.
- (c) If 15 to 20% less than BOQ rate additional performance guarantee will be @ 1% for every 1% less rate.
- (d) If above 20% less than BOQ rate additional performance guarantee will be @ 2% for every 1% less rate.

27. Character certificate issued by the District Magistrate/Reserve Superintendent will have to be given.

28. The undersigned has the right to extend, accept or reject the tender without assigning any reason thereof.

29. No claim shall be entertained because of disruption of internet service being used by the bidders. Bidders are advised to upload their bids well in advance to avoid last minute technical snags.
